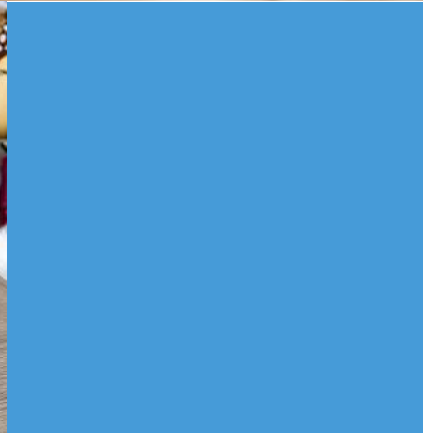
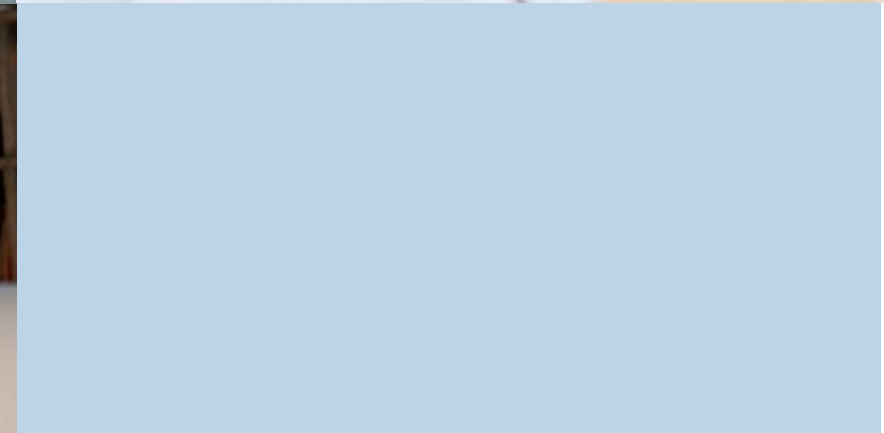

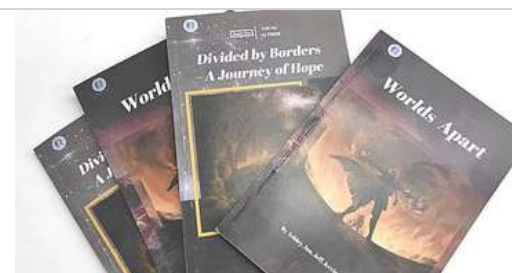

Identifying Appeals in a Text: Look for Ethos, Pathos, Logos

During one northern expedition in 2009 we journeyed to the Great Detached Reef in the company of Dr. J.E.N. "Charlie" Veron, the former director of the Australian Institute of Marine Science. His book, "A Reef in Time," is a primer on the Great Barrier Reef and climate change... Veron guided us to the richest sites recorded in his...notebooks. We dove on robust reefs, every inch of space taken up by thriving hard corals fighting for space.

Once, we were focused on a coral subject when silvertip sharks appeared to investigate the fuss in their backyard, followed moments later by a very large hammerhead shark that circled us and left unimpressed. On our return we discovered a dead sperm whale... and eight rotund tiger sharks were taking turns feeding on the oily white carcass. We slid into the water and documented these magnificent predators on their terms. Encountering so many shark species...was a welcome indicator of a healthy ecosystem.

On another overcast November day 1999 I chartered a twin-engine Aero-Commander in Cairns, Queensland, and flew north along the reef to make a set of aerial photographs. Four hundred miles, countless reefs and three hours later...I looked out the window from 2,500 feet and saw thousands of clumps of algae surrounding the island.

We circled and descended and I realized I was not looking at algae at all. I was looking at tens of thousands of sea turtles, layers deep in the water. I was staring at the largest green sea turtle rookery in the world: Raine Island, a 1.8 km speck of sand that attracts up to 25,000 females a night to lay their eggs under the cover of darkness. This congregation of green sea turtles migrated here as their ancestors have for generations before them.

We flew back to Cairns and returned by boat to Raine Island with a team of scientists and park rangers. I entered the water to witness the most dramatic pulse of life I have ever seen in the sea. Thousands of sea turtles directly in front me were perfectly camouflaged, blending into the healthy reef scape and disappearing from a predators' -- and my -- view.

Looking at so many gathered in one place, one might wonder: How can these sea turtles be an endangered species? That was exactly the point. This was Earth's mother lode of green sea turtles, all in one very small place and very vulnerable to human-induced or natural disaster. I did not know it then, but they may well be the last generation to lay their eggs on Raine Island.

The die-off of the Great Barrier Reef isn't just about losing coral. A slight rise in sea level, and the ocean will claim Raine Island as her own and the largest green sea turtle rookery on Earth will vanish, existing only as genetic GPS code in these wonderful ancient mariners.

Creative Reading and Writing

Level 1

Created for students in Grades 2-3, this course is dedicated to improving students' vocabulary knowledge and comprehension skills, as well narrative composition skills.

Level 4

Created for students in Grades 5-6, this course will extend and expand upon the knowledge gained in Level 3 by introducing a variety of new text types that students must master to succeed at the highest levels of English education.

Level 2

Created for students in Grades 3-4, this course will explore non-fiction text-types to develop a deep understanding of the ideas, features and techniques used in non-fiction.

Level 5

Created for students in Grades 6-7, this course will teach pupils to create their own entertaining and detailed short stories, which illustrate an in-depth understanding of literary skills and techniques. Students will also be introduced to literary analysis.

Level 3

Created for students in Grades 4-5, this course will examine narrative, descriptive, informational, and persuasive writing, with the goal of improving composition and comprehension skills in these core genres.

Level 6

Created for students in Grades 7-8, this course will sharpen students' analytical reading and writing skills by consolidating their understanding of rhetorical and literary analysis, as well as research-based, reflective, and empathic writing, through the study of impactful canonical texts.

Literature Studies

Young Classics

Students in these courses will read the Sterling Classic Starts versions of celebrated classic literature. The Sterling series is leveled according to age and reading ability so you can be sure that your child will understand and meaningfully connect with every story.

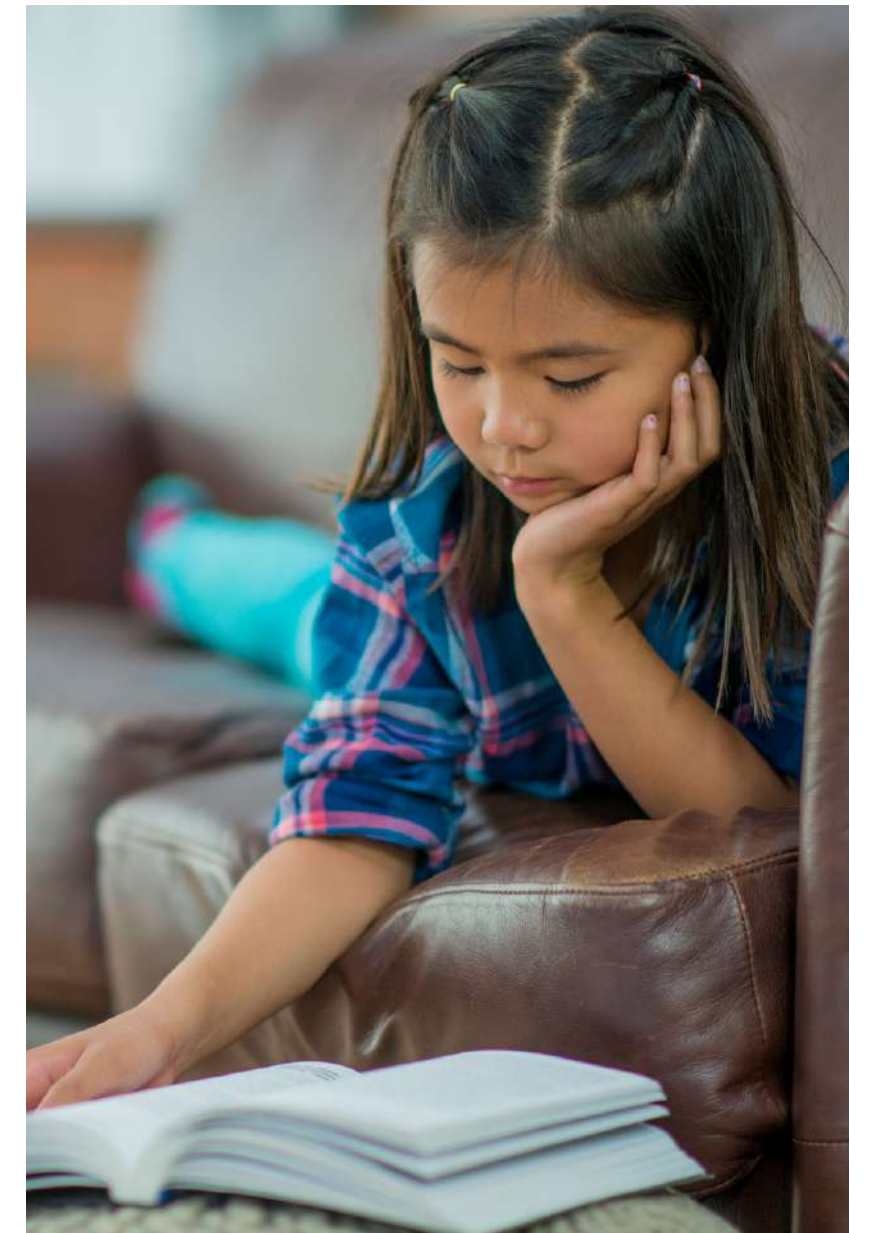
Advanced Literature Book Club

This course enhances student ability to understand, identify, comment on, and utilize advanced literary techniques found throughout English literature. In this process, students will establish their own unique writer's voice.

Additional English Courses

Vocabulary

Vocabulary is the foundation of effective communication. It is crucial for students to study how to use appropriate words for maximum impact.

In our Vocabulary Course, through game interaction, the study of word parts, and more, we help students to acquire the ability to learn words independently. At each of our 3 levels, students will acquire 100 words above their grade level!

4 sessions, monthly enrollment, target G2~G7 students.

Grammar

Our Grammar Workshop Course will give students an opportunity to make coherent sentences and get their point across accurately. They will study English tenses, compound and complex sentences, passives, sub-junction, and more.

Students will be able to recognize and understand the meaning of targeted grammatical structures, to use targeted grammatical structures meaningfully and appropriately, and to self-correct grammatical mistakes. Our Grammar courses are taught by bilingual teachers who have unique insight into your child's academic needs.

8 sessions, target G3~G6 students.

Reading Comprehension

Many international schools use MAP as a standardized tool to assess reading fluency and comprehension.

MAP Reading can be a challenging area for students. Therefore, to help students improve their MAP score, our MAP Reading Comprehension Course focuses on the following aspects: informational text, foundational skills and terminology, literary devices, vocabulary, and main ideas.

10 sessions, target G2~G6 students.

Math Courses



Singapore Math

The Singapore math method is a highly effective teaching approach which has been adopted by many international schools in the past 20 years. The course is unique, as it helps train students' logical thinking skills. In contrast to U.S. math programs, in which concepts and skills are more compartmentalized within and across grade levels, Singapore math puts a strong emphasis on weaving previous lessons into new content.

Common key features of Singapore Math include CPA (Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract) progression, number bonds, bar modeling, and mental math.

Reach Out works with Math teachers from Singapore, who not only have rich teaching experience, but also have expertise in this unique approach.

Pre- IGCSE

Many prestigious international schools, such as YKP and SHSID, adopt the IGCSE Math Curriculum starting in high-school. Content covered at the IGCSE bridges directly into IB and A-Level curriculums, so if students do not have a solid foundation in IGCSE study, they may experience difficulty in succeeding on their IB or A-Level Math examinations.

Students usually have academic, as well as university enrollment pressure when they step into high school, so studying the IGCSE curriculum 2 years in advance will better prepare them for success.

At Reach Out, we offer two levels of IGCSE courses: the 0607 version for standard classes, and the 0606 version for advanced classes.

Enhancing Math Program

Our Reach Out Enhancing Math Program is based on the textbook used by the majority of international schools, **Scott Foresman-Addison Wesley**.

Our educators carry out in-depth, research-based practices on the corresponding learning objectives in class, allowing students to master more problem-solving methods and skills, cultivate new ideas, and deeply analyze difficult questions one by one in each chapter. In addition, this course will help students consolidate what they've learned at school.

For parents looking for a more personalized approach, we offer tailored 1-on-1 tutoring with programs of study designed for your child's unique needs and goals.

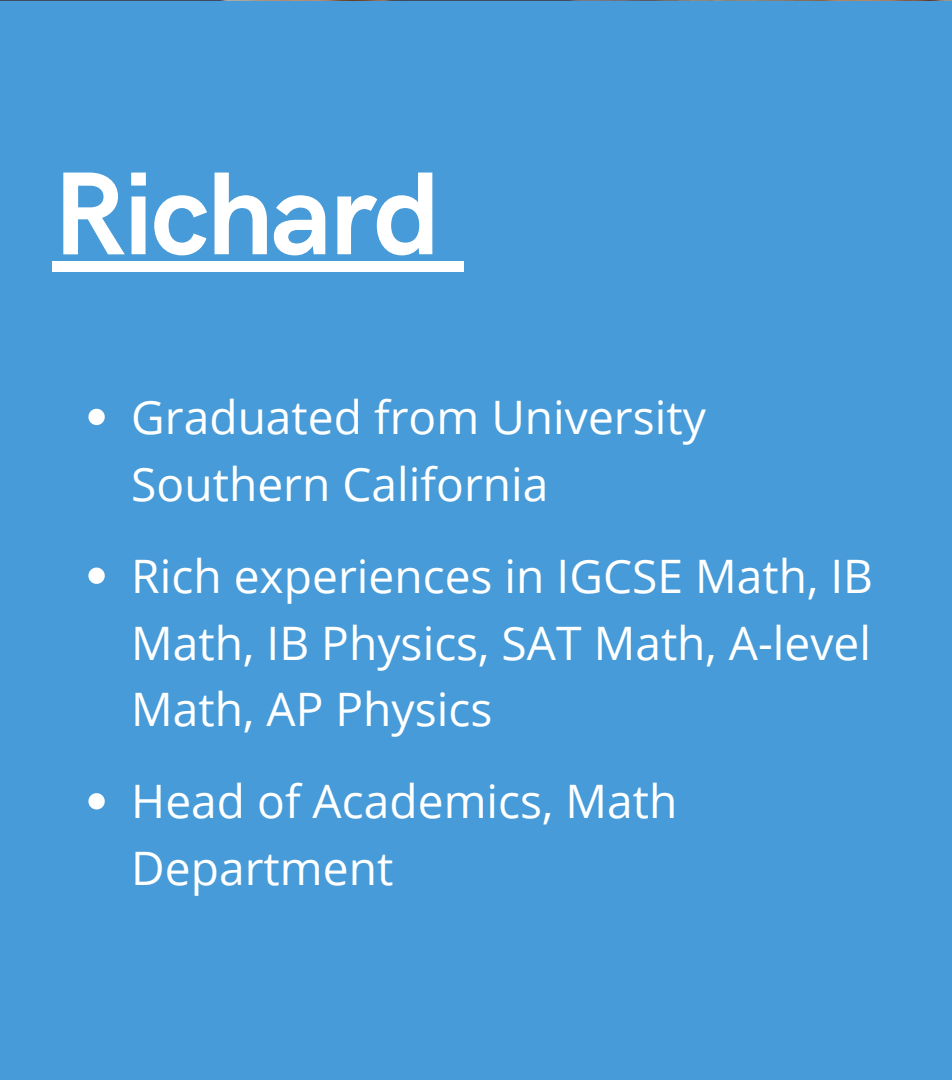
